

# Burgundy Triangles Doily

Approx Size 6"  
Cotton Crochet Thread 10  
Crochet Hook Size 5

## Ch 6, sl st to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 4, (dc, ch 1) 11 times in ring, join with sl st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch 4.

**Rnd 2:** Sl st in ch 1 sp, ch 3, dc in same sp, ch 2 \* 2 dc in next space, ch 2, repeat from \* around, join.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc \* ch 2, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, Repeat from \* around, join.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, dc in same sp as joining, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, \*ch 4, sk next dc, 1 sc in next dc, ch 4, sk next dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, repeat from \* around. Join.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 3, dc in same sp, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, \*(ch 4, sc in next ch 4 sp) twice ch 4, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, repeat from \* around. Join.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 4, \*sc in 4<sup>th</sup> dc, ch 4 sc in last dc, ch 4, sk next ch sp, 2 dc in next ch sp, ch 4 sk next ch sp, sc in next dc,. Repeat from \* around, join with sl st to base of beg ch 4.

**Rnd 7:** Sl st, ch 1, sc in ch 4 sp (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 2 times, ch 4, \*dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 4 times ch 4, Repeat from \* around. Join to first sc.

**Rnd 8:** Sl st, ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch sp, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 2 times, ch 4, \*2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 5 times, ch 4, Repeat from \* around, join.

**Rnd 9:** Sl st, ch 1, sc in next ch sp, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) twice, \* 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, sc in next ch 4 sp (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 5 times. Repeat from \* around, ending in ch 1, dc in 1<sup>st</sup> sc to form last ch 4 sp.

**Rnd 10:** Ch 3, dc in same sp as joining \*(ch 4, sc in next ch sp) twice, ch 4, sc in 4<sup>th</sup> dc, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 2 times, ch 4, 2 dc in next ch sp, repat from \* around, join.

**Rnd 11:** Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc \*(ch 4, sc in next sp) 6 times, ch 4, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, Repeat from \* around, join.

**Rnd 12:** Ch 3, dc in same sp, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc \*(ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 7 times, ch 4, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, repeat from \* around, join.

**Rnd 13:** Ch 3, dc in same sp, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, \*(ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 8 times, ch 4, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of the next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, repeat from \* around, join.

**Rnd 14:** sc in same sp as joining, sc in next 2 dc, ch 5, sk next sc, sc in each of the next 3 dc \* [(sc, ch 4, sc) in next ch sp, 3 sc in next sp] 5 times, sc in each of the next 3 dc, ch 5, sk next dc, sc in each of the next 3 dc, repeat from \* around, join. Fasten off.



To shape lay piece on the ironing board with a tea towel underneath. Spray with spray starch, shape as needed with hands. Fold tea towel over the top of doily and press firmly with hot iron. Allow to dry before picking up. The tea towel allows you to use a hot iron to press and starch firmly without scorching the doily.

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
