

Triangles Doily

Approx Size 6"
Cotton Crochet Thread 10
Crochet Hook Size 5

Ch 6, sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 4, (dc, ch 1) 11 times in ring, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 4. (12 dcs, 12 ch 1 sps)

Rnd 2: Sl st in ch 1 sp, ch 3, dc in same sp, ch 2 * 2 dc in next space, ch 2, repeat from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. (12 ch 2 sps)

Rnd 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc * ch 2, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, Repeat from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in same sp as joining, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, *ch 4, sk next dc, 1 sc in next dc, ch 4, sk next dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, repeat from * around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. (12 ch 4 sps, 30 dc)

Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in same sp, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, *(ch 4, sc in next ch 4 sp) twice ch 4, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, repeat from * around. Join to top of beg ch 3. (18 ch 4 sps)

Rnd 6: In same space as join, ch 1 sc, Ch 4, *sc in 4th dc, ch 4 sc in last dc, ch 4, sk next ch sp, 2 dc in next ch sp, ch 4 sk next ch sp, sc in next dc., Repeat from * around, join with sl st to beg sc. (32 ch 4 sps, 12 dc)

Rnd 7: Sl st, ch 1, sc in ch 4 sp (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 2 times, ch 4, *dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 4 times ch 4, Repeat from * around. Join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 8: Sl st, ch 1, sc in 1st ch sp, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 2 times, ch 4, *2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 5 times, ch 4, Repeat from * around, join.

Rnd 9: Sl st, ch 1, sc in next ch sp, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) twice, * 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, sk next ch 4, sc in next ch 4 sp (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 4 times, ch 4 sk next ch sp. Repeat from * around, ending in ch 1, dc in 1st sc to form last ch 4 sp. (30 ch 4 sps)

Rnd 10: Ch 3, dc in same sp as joining *(ch 4, sc in next ch sp) twice, ch 4, sc in 4th dc, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 2 times, ch 4, 2 dc in next ch sp, repeat from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3 (36 ch 4 sps).

Rnd 11: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc *(ch 4, sc in next sp) 6 times, ch 4, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, Repeat from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. (42 ch 4 sps)

Rnd 12: Ch 3, dc in same sp, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc *(ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 7 times, ch 4, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, repeat from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. (48 ch 4 sps)

Rnd 13: Ch 3, dc in same sp, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, *(ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 8 times, ch 4, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of the next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, repeat from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. (54 ch 4 sps)

Rnd 14: sc in same sp as joining, sc in next 2 dc, ch 5, sk next sc, sc in each of the next 3 dc * [(sc, ch 4, sc) in next ch sp, 3 sc in next sp] 4 times, sc, ch 4, sc in next ch 4 sp, sc in each of the next 3 dc, ch 5, sk next dc, sc in each of the next 3 dc, repeat from * around, join. Fasten off.



To shape lay piece on the ironing board with a tea towel underneath. Spray with spray starch, shape as needed with hands. Fold tea towel over the top of doily and press firmly with hot iron. Allow to dry before picking up. The tea towel allows you to use a hot iron to press and starch firmly without scorching the doily.

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
