

My Rose Doily

Designed by Nancy Livengood

I designed this doily to for my sister-in-law, who had redecorated her living room. She wanted something to go under her lamps to keep them from scratching her new end table. This is the design I came up with. The base of the lamp is 7 inches in diameter.

Steel crochet hooks size 3 and 8
Size 10 cotton crochet thread
1 ball forest green
1 ball dusty rose
1 ball burgundy
1 ball natural

Flowers (Make 10)

For flowers use hook size 8
Flowers are approx 1 ½ in across from petal tip to petal tip



With burgundy ch 6 sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: ch 6 (counts as 1st dc and ch 3) (dc in ring, ch 3) 5 times join to top of ch 3. - 6 ch 3 spaces.

Rnd 2: sl st in 1st ch 3 sp, * (ch 1, sc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2, sc) in same sp. Repeat from * in each ch space around. Join with sl st in first sc. 6 petals.

Rnd 3: ch 1, working in back of petals ch 1, sc in post of dc in 1st rnd *(ch 5, sc in next post) repeat round ending with sl st in first sc made.

Rnd 4: sl st in 1st ch 5 space ch 1, *sc, ch 2, 2 dc, 1 trc, 2 dc, ch 2, 1 sc, all in the same ch 5 space. Repeat from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off

Flower center

Rnd 1: with dusty rose attach with sc to any dc post in the front center of the flower, * ch 3, sc in next post repeat from * around, join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 2: sl st in 1st ch sp, 2 sc in each ch sp around, join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 3: ch 1, sc in every other sc around, fasten off, pull loose threads to the back of the flower and weave in ends.



Doily

Use crochet hook size 3

With natural ch 8, join to form a ring.

Rnd 1: ch 3, 15 dc in ring, join 16 dc.

Rnd 2: ch 3, dc in same sp, dc in next dc, *2 dc in next dc;, dc in next dc repeat from * around, join – 24 dc

Rnd 3: ch 3, dc in same sp, 2 dc in next dc, *dc in next dc, 2 dc in next 2 dc, repeat from * around, join - 40 dc.

Rnd 4: ch 3, dc in same sp, dc in next sp, *2 dc in next sp, dc in next sp, repeat from * around, join – 60 dc

Rnd 5: ch 3, dc in same sp, *dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, repeat from * around, join – 80 dc

Rnd 6: ch 3, dc in same sp, dc in next 3 dc, *2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, repeat from * around, join.

Rnd 7: Repeat rnd 6 - 125 dc

Rnd 8: ch 3, dc in same sp, dc in next 4 dc, *2 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc, repeat from * around, join – 150 dc

Rnd 9-12: ch 3, dc in next dc and each dc around, join.

Rnd 13: ch 3, dc in next 3 dc, * ch 2 sk next 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 5 dc, repeat from * around ending in dc in last dc, join – 30 ch 2 spaces

Rnd 14: ch 3, dc in next 3 dc, * ch 3, sc in ch sp, ch 3, dc in next 3 dc, ch 3, sc in next ch sp, ch 3, dc in next 5 dc, repeat from * around ending in ch 3, sc in ch sp, dc in last dc, join, fasten off.

Rnd 15: In 1st ch 3 sp next to 5 dc group join forest green with sl st, ch 1, sc in same ch 3 sp, ch 4, *sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 4, sk next dc sc in next dc, ch 4, sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 4, sk next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 4, repeat from * around, join to 1 sc.

Rnd 16: sl st in next ch sp, ch 1, sc in same space (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 2 times, *(ch 4 dc in next ch sp, dc in next 2 dc, dc in next ch sp, (ch 4, sc in next ch sp) 4 times, repeat from * around, join.

Rnd 17: Rose attaching round.

Sl in in 1st ch sp, ch 1, *(sc, ch 3, sc in same sp) Repeat () in next 2 ch sps, ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 3, sc in next sp, ch 3, sc, ch 3 in same sp, sc in next sp, (now with right sides facing attach rose with sc in any tr cr of the rose, sc in same sp, in next ch 3 sp (sc, ch sc) ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 3, sc in next sp, in each of the next 3 ch sp, (sc, ch 3, sc) ch 3, sc in next ch sp, ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, work 1st half of dc and attach rose by inserting hook in any tr cr of rose pull up a loop yo and pull up through all 3 loops on hook, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc. Repeat around, ending in ch 3, sc in next ch sp, join to 1st sc, fasten off.

Now you will work in rows between each flower.

Row 1: working from right to left, attach forest green with sc to the TRC of the flower petal, so that you are working toward the 6 dc group closest to the next flower.

Ch 3, sk 1st ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 3, sk next sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 3, sc in space between 3rd & 4th dc, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 3, sk last ch sp, sc in TRC of next flower, ch 3 turn.

Row 2: sk 1st ch 3 sp, sc in next ch 3 sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch sp across to las 2 ch sps, ch 3 sl st in the sc made in TRC of flower. Ch 3 turn

Row 3: (sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 3) Repeat across, ch 3 sc in next TRC of next flower, ch 3 turn.

Row 4: sk 1st ch 3 sp (sc in next sp, ch 3) across ending in ch 3, sc in trc of next flower, ch 3 turn.

Row 5: sk 1st ch sp (sc in next ch sp, ch 3) across ending with sk last ch 3 sp sl st in sc made in flower, ch 3 turn

Row 6: (sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 3) across, ending in sc in last ch 3 sp fasten off. 5 ch 3 spaces.

Repeat rows 1-6 in each section between flowers, turn piece over and work every other section starting from the back side.

Now you will be working in full rounds again.

Rnd 1: Attach forest green to top of any flower in the TRC sp of the flower, ch 1 sc in same space as joining, ch 6 *sc in next sc (at the sc made in next flower petal on row 6, ch 3, sc in next ch sp, repeat from * 5 times, ch 3 sc in next sc made in next flower petal, ch 6, sc in TRC of flower, ch 6 repeat from * around ending in ch 6 join with sl st to 1st sc. (there will be 6 ch 3 spaces between each flower)

Rnd 2: ch 1 sc in same sp, ch 3, 2 sc in ch 6 sp * ch 3, (dc, ch, dc in next ch 3 sp) 6 times, ch 3, 2 sc in ch 6 sp, ch 3, sc in sc, ch 3, 2 sc in ch 6 sp repeat from * around ending with ch 3 join at sl st to 1st sc.

Rnd 3: ch 1, sc in same sp, ch 3, sc in ch 3 sp, sc in next 2 sc, sc in ch 3 sp, *ch 3, (dc, ch 1, dc in next ch 1 sp) 3 times, dc, ch 1, dc in sp between next 2 dc, (dc, ch 1, dc in next sp) 3 times, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp, sc in next 2 sc, sc in next ch 3, ch 3, sc in sc, ch 3, sc in ch 3 sp, sc in next 2 sc, sc in next ch 3 sp, repeat from * around ending in ch 3 sl st to 1st sc, fasten off.

Rnd 4: Attach natural with sc in same space as joining on rnd 3, *sc in ch 3 sp, ch 3, sk 1st sc, sc in next 2 sc, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 3 (dc, ch 1, dc in next ch 1 sp) 5 times, ch 3 sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 3, sk 1st sc, sc in next 2 sc, ch 3, sc in ch 3 sp, sc in sc, sc in next ch 3, ch 3, repeat from * around ending in ch 3, sl st to 1st sc.

Rnd 5: ch 1, sc in same st as joining, (ch 3, sc in next ch sp) 4 times *ch 3, sc in ch 1 sp, ch 3 (dc, ch 1, dc in next ch 1 sp – **V Stitch Made**) 3 times, ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp) 3 times, ch 3, sk 1st sc, sc in next sc (ch 3, sc in next ch sp) 4 times repeat from* ending in ch 3, join with sl st to 1st sc. 12 ch 3 space between V-stitches)

Rnd 6: ch 1, sc in same sp as joining, (ch 3, sc in next ch sp) 6 times *ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp. V-stitch in next ch 1 sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp) 11 times repeat from * around ending in ch 3, sk last ch 3 sp, sl st in 1st sc, fasten off.

Rnd 7: join rose with sc in 1st ch 3 sp next to joining, *(ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp) repeat to ch 1 sp, ch 3, dc ch 1, dc in ch 1 sp, repeat from * around join with sl st to 1st sc fasten off.

Rnd 8: join burgundy with ch 3 sp next to joining, (ch 3, sc in each ch3 and each ch 1 sp around join to 1st sc, fasten off.

Press with spray starch between two layers of a tea towel. Carefully press between flowers to avoid flattening them.

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
